Sylvania Prom Rules of Conduct and Dress Code

New Covid-Related Guidelines

- Mask are required for students and their guests.
- Attendance is restricted to students, their guests, and faculty/administration. Parents will not be allowed to attend for lead-out.

General Guidelines

- Prom is a school-sponsored activity; ALL school rules apply.
- Once a student leaves the prom, he/she will not be allowed to re-enter.
- No obscene or suggestive dancing.
- All students and guests must follow the prom dress code and rules of conduct.
- Age guidelines for students' guests: currently 9th grade 20 years old.
- Any student or guest who violates the rules of behavior or dress code may be asked to leave the premises by SHS administrators.

Dress Code for Ladies

- Dresses are to be formal or semi-formal.
- Dresses may be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.
- Dresses may not have low-cut or plunging necklines
- Backless dresses may not expose below the waistline.
- Two-piece dresses may expose no more than 1-2 inches of bare midriff.
- Dresses with slits: slit must extend to mid-thigh or below.

Dress Code for Gentlemen

- Tuxedos or dress suits are required
- Collared shirt and tie are required
- Shirts must have sleeves
- Shirts must remain on
- Dress pants or slacks; no jeans
- Formal style hats are allowed; baseball hats are not
